

■ 3 - 5 YRS - KNOW THAT OTHERS HAVE DIFFERENT THOUGHTS THAN THEM






TEENS' USE OF CELL PHONES & TECHNOLOGY ACCESS




Texting is like a conversation. We need to keep it going!




REMEMBER:

- DELETE emails from strangers/websites (SPAM)



- # Hashtags are another way to work on main idea, details and sentence formulation
- # Weekly Homework assignment = comment or add





