Day Programs

CBDS Mobile

This program is an employment-centric community-based vehicle for individuals to engage in meaningful, purposeful activities that enhance their lives.

ABI Program

This program focuses on building one's optimal level in social skills, communication, behavior management, self-help abilities, and activities of daily living for those with Acquired Brain Injury.

Day Hab

This program primarily addresses the medical, clinical and therapeutic needs of each Guest. With a concentration on sensorimotor, communication, social, independent living, affective and behavior development, it is designed to improve communication and self-help skills in both traditional and innovative settings.

StarWorks

This program builds confidence and skills leading to employment for people of all levels of abilities and challenges.

ISS/IHS

Individual Support Services provides flexible supports based on peoples' needs while In-Home Supports provides services to individuals and their families at their own homes, including respite services.

This program features group-supported employment sites as well as individualized job coaching.
